


Child Life Certification Commission Operational Policy and Procedure

Standing Committees

The CLCC has the authority to appoint committees. Committees of the CLCC are committees that meet on a regular basis to complete the ongoing work of the Commission and include commission standing committees, exam development committees, and other committees. All committees report to the CLCC. All members of all committees are required to sign confidentiality/conflict of interest statements to ensure that confidentiality, autonomy and impartiality are maintained regarding the certification program.

Task Forces

Task forces address specific short-term issues. The CLCC Chairperson will have the authority to appoint and dissolve task forces as needed based on the activities of the CLCC.
