Why survey individual CCLSs rather than programs?











Job Role (percentage of CCLS respondents)





Does your hospital consider child life essential? (percentage of program leader respondents)







- when elective surgeries resume








Job Role (percentage of CCLS respondents)




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CCLS able to work from home (percentage of CCLS respondents)



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








Job Role (percentage of CCLS respondents)






Work from Home Tasks (number of CCLS respondents)



Does your hospital consider child life essential? (percentage of program leader respondents)




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
