Mentees

- Hold the Certified Child Life Specialist credential as of January 2019
- Be a professional member of the Association of Child Life Professionals throughout the entire program
- Be currently employed as a Certified Child Life Specialist, with at least one year of paid work experience attained by January 2019.
- Describe a general learning or professional development focus
- Demonstrate self-motivation and a desire to develop and/or enhance leadership skills
- Provide a completed application, résumé, and recommendation form from current supervisor by Monday, September 16, 2019. Notification of acceptance or declination to the program will be provided in December 2019

Mentors

- Hold the Certified Child Life Specialist credential and be employed as a CCLS for at least 3 years by January 2020.
- Be a professional member of the Association of Child Life Professionals throughout the entire program
- Identify and describe skills or talents that could be shared with a mentee, as well as desire to support a mentee.
- Provide a completed application, résumé, and recommendation form from a colleague or supervisor (who can speak about your professional work and the strengths you will bring to the mentor role) by Monday, September 16. If your recommendation form is being completed by someone who is not your supervisor, it is suggested that you discuss your participation in the program with your supervisor prior to submitting your application.
